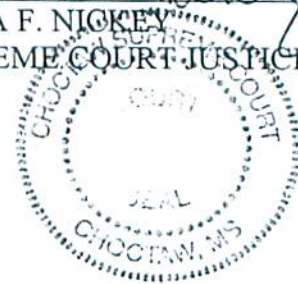
ORDER DENYING APPEAL



