



JUDGMENT

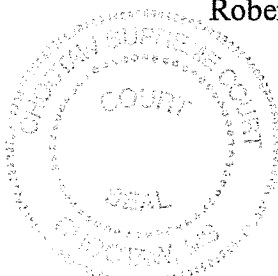
