That Ms. John now seeks to voluntarily withdraw her appeal and has provided a sworn affidavit requesting such relief.

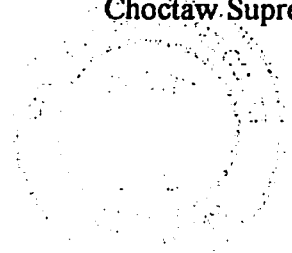
That Counsel for the Appellant has contacted the Honorable Timothy Taylor, counsel for the Appellee who has advised that he has no objection to the Appellant's motion.
