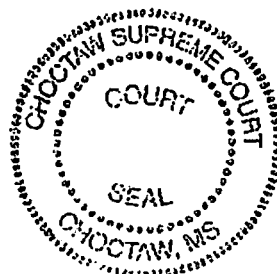

ORDER OF DISMISSAL




