MINUTE ORDER

This Court upon review and consideration of the record, briefs, and oral arguments in the above captioned case, hereby reverses Judge Taylors' order dismissing the case with prejudice. The Court finds reversible error with Judge Taylor's finding of a lack of probable cause and lack of exigent circumstances and failure of the tribe to obtain a search warrant. We find the principles recognized in *Brigham City v. Stuart*, 547 U.S. 398 (2006), as an exception to the 4th Amendment's warrant requirement controlling whereunder "[o]ne exigency obviating the requirement of a warrant is the need to assist persons who are seriously injured or threatened with such injury. The need to protect or preserve life or avoid serious injury is justification for what would otherwise be illegal absent an exigency or emergency." (Internal quotations and citations omitted).

The Court reserves the issue of whether double jeopardy affects the ultimate disposition of this case pending simultaneous briefing of the parties that is due to the Court on or before November 17, 2017.
